Mr. Napolitano is the Director of the Clean Air Markets Division in the Office of Air and Radiation in the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This group runs six air emission trading programs that reduce sulfur dioxide, nitrogen oxides, and mercury emissions from the electric power industry to protect public health, welfare, and the environment. The Division also serves as a focal point for the design, evaluation, and training of others on air emission reductions and other environmental trading programs under consideration by Congress, state and local governments, and foreign countries (e.g., China, Canada, and Chile). Mr. Napolitano has 31 years of experience working on pollution issues related to air, water, and waste; over 24 years of that experience has been with the EPA. For the last 14 years, he has worked in the EPA Office of Air and Radiation. Mr. Napolitano also spent two years as a Division Director in the Office of the Secretary of Defense developing environmental compliance policies for military installations worldwide, and five years as a Vice President for the Risk Assessment and Economic Analysis Unit of ICF Incorporated.
